Membership Categories

Family Member Fee: £215.00	Definition: A sailing member with sailing spouse / domestic partner and any children (under 18 years old) living at the same address. Duties: Both adults are each required to complete two assigned duties per year.
Single Member Fee: £114.00	Definition: A sailing member aged 18 years or over (If there are sailing children, a cadet membership should be taken out). Duties: Two assigned duties per year are required to be completed.
Student Member Fee: £28.50	Definition: A sailing member aged 18 years or over and in further education. Duties: Two assigned duties per year are required to be completed
Non-Sailing Member Fee: £28.50	Definition: A non-sailing member shall have a interest in the club. But not desirous of taking part in the water activities Duties: A non-sailing member is not required to fulfil any duty
Cadet Member Fee: £28.50	Definition: A sailing member under 18 years old. Duties: A Cadet member is not required to fulfil any duty.
Honorary, Life Member Fee: £0.00	Definition: An honorary or life membership is proposed by the General committee and ratified at a club AGM. Duties: An honorary or life member is not required to fulfil any duty

Memberships are valid from 1st March to the last day of February of the following year.

Membership fee must be paid before the first day of sailing otherwise your sailing results will not be counted.

Duties

The club duty rota organises the members required to run the water and family activities throughout the season. All sailing, family, student members over the age of 18 year must each fulfil two duties in a season. The duty rota can be found on the dutyman website. It is the member's responsibility to arrange a swap and to advise the sailing secretary of any changes to duty.
